TOWN OF SEABROOK Mosquito Control

The Mosquito Control program begins the week of April 4, 2016 in the Town of Seabrook. Crews from Dragon Mosquito Control will be checking swamps, salt marshes, woodland pools, ditches, storm drains and other shallow, stagnant water for mosquito larvae. When mosquitoes are found, the following insecticides may be used:

VectoBac (Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis)

Natular (spinosad)

Altosid (methoprene)

AquaBac 200G (Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis)

Abate (temephos)

CocoBear MLO (mineral oil)

BVA 2 MLO (highly refined petroleum distillate)

Control of adult mosquitoes may be done at the following locations in preparation for Old Home Days Celebration in August, for sporting events, to reduce nuisance mosquitoes or if Eastern Equine Encephalitis or West Nile Virus is found in or near Seabrook:

Seabrook Elementary & Middle School

Community Center

Veteran's Memorial Park

Seabreeze Village

Governor Weare Park Seabrook Gun Range

Department of Public Works

Adult mosquito control will be accomplished using one or more of the following products:

Cross Check Plus (bifenthrin)

Permanone (permethrin)

Duet (sumithrin &prallethrin)

Zenivex (etofenprox)

DeltaGard (deltamethrin) Mavrik Perimeter (tau-fluvalinate)

Essentria IC3 (rosemary oil, geraniol, peppermint oil)

A truck mounted sprayer could also be used to disperse Duet (sumithrin &prallethrin) or Zenivex (etofenprox) along roadways during a public health threat. It is not possible to predict if emergency spraying will be necessary. The spray schedule is based upon mosquito surveillance data, disease test results and weather conditions. Further communication will be given if emergency spraying is going to take place.
