ARTICLE I
General Provisions

§ 249-1. Amendments.

With the exception of § 249-5, Traffic control signals, § 249-9, Vehicle weight limits, § 249-20, Schedule I: Traffic control signals, and § 249-24, Schedule V: Vehicle weight limits, the provisions of this chapter may be amended by ordinance of the Board of Selectmen.

§ 249-2. Repealer.

All prior ordinances and other enactments, or parts of such, of this Town regulating traffic and parking are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance or other enactment hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this chapter.

§ 249-3. Severability.

If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or provision of this chapter shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the article, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or provision thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

§ 249-4. Violations and penalties. [Amended BOS 9-28-2005]

Unless otherwise indicated, any person who violates this chapter shall be fined not less than \$50 nor more than \$100, with such penalties to inure to such purposes as the Town may direct.

ARTICLE II
Traffic Regulations

§ 249-5. Traffic control signals.

Traffic control signals shall be installed and operated at the intersection of those streets described in Schedule I (§ 249-20), attached to and made a part of this chapter.

§ 249-6. Speed limits. [Amended BOS 9-28-2005]

The speed limits governing the speed of traffic on and along the public streets and highways or any parts thereof under the legal control of the Town of Seabrook as described in Schedule II (§ 249-21) within this chapter are hereby established at the rates of speed indicated in said Schedule II, but the speed limits specified therein shall not be less than 30 miles per hour unless a traffic study is completed in accordance with state requirements that justifies a speed limit of not less than 25 miles per hour.

§ 249-7. One-way streets.

The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule III (§ 249-22), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as one-way streets upon which traffic shall proceed only in the direction indicated.

§ 249-8. Stop intersections.

The intersections described in Schedule IV (§ 249-23), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as stop intersections, and any vehicle approaching such intersections on the first-named streets shall come to a full stop before entering said intersections.

§ 249-9. Vehicle weight limits.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any commercial vehicle or other tractor, trailer or tractor-trailer combination having a gross weight in excess of that prescribed, upon any of the streets or portions thereof described in Schedule V (§ 249-24), except for the purpose of making local deliveries on that street.
- B. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision enacted pursuant to Subsection A shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$100 for each offense.

ARTICLE III
Parking Restrictions

§ 249-10. Violations and penalties.

The following penalties are hereby imposed for violations of the article:

- A. Twenty-five dollars for the first violation, and, for each subsequent violation, the illegally parked vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense. **[Amended 3-13-1992 ATM by Art. 36; amended 3-11-1993 ATM by Art. 16]**
- B. Vehicles illegally parked according to any section of this article will be subject to towing on the first offense at the owner's expense if the parked vehicle impedes or interferes with proper public safety and traffic control. **[Amended 3-11-1993 ATM by Art. 16]**

§ 249-11. Parking prohibited at all times.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule VI (§ 249-25), attached to and made a part of this chapter.

§ 249-11.1. Parking prohibited at certain times.

No person shall park a vehicle during any of the times indicated upon any of the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule VII (§ 249-26), attached to and made a part of this chapter.

§ 249-12. Parking area north of Warren West Memorial Building. [Added 3-11-1993 ATM by Art. 12]

- A. No person shall park any bus or trailer truck at the beach parking area north of the Warren West Memorial Building on Route 1A unless authorized by the Selectmen for a special Town event or activity.
- B. No person shall park any camper, camper trailer or mobile home at the beach parking area north of the Warren West building on Route 1A at any time without a Town parking permit.

§ 249-13. Interference with snow-clearing operations.

No person having the custody or control of any vehicle shall stop or cause to be stopped or park on any public street or highway in the Town of Seabrook so as to impede or interfere with the proper snow-clearing operations of the Town.

§ 249-14. General parking prohibitions. [Amended 3-14-2000 ATM by Art. 43; BOS 9-28-2005]

No person having the custody or control of any vehicle, registered or unregistered, licensed or unlicensed, shall stop or cause to be stopped or parked or to be standing on any public street or highway within the Town of Seabrook so as to impede or interfere with any of the following where no parking is allowed at any time:

- A. Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- B. Within 20 feet of the intersection of two streets or highways.
- C. Within 50 feet of the termination of a dead-end street or highway.
- D. Within the paved or unpaved center of a cul-de-sac.
- E. In front of an approved and permitted driveway that is not more than 20 feet in width.
- F. At Seabrook Beach in the rights-of-way to the beach.
- G. By a vehicle that is over 30 feet in length and within 100 feet of an intersection.

H. No parking shall be allowed on a public sidewalk at any time. **[Added BOS 12-14-2005]**

§ 249-15. Parking where signs restrict.

- A. No person shall park any vehicle on any real estate owned by the Town of Seabrook where, at the direction of the Selectmen, a sign clearly indicating that parking is not permitted on said premises has been erected.
- B. No person shall park any vehicle on any street or road within the Town of Seabrook on which parking is subject to regulation by the Selectmen of the Town where, at the direction of the Selectmen, a sign has been erected.

§ 249-16. Definitions.

As used in this article, the following phrases shall have the meanings indicated:

VEHICLE — Includes any bus, highway equipment, motorcycle, motor truck, motor vehicle, semitrailer, sidecar, tractor, trailer or other vehicle defined by RSA 259:1, as amended, and shall also include any camper trailer or mobile home, whether or not occupied.

§ 249-17. Town pier. [Amended 3-13-1992 ATM by Art. 34]

No person shall park any vehicle in the Town pier parking lot at River Street at any time without a Town parking permit. Said permit must be located in a conspicuous place on a window in the vehicle. All vehicles shall park in properly designated spots.

§ 249-18. Parking by permit in Seabrook Beach. [Amended 6-21-1989, ratified 3-15-1990 ATM by Art. 17; 3-11-1993 ATM by Art. 10; 4-8-1997 ATM by Art. 28; 2-8-2005 ATM by Art. 50;¹ BOS 9-28-2005; BOS 6-21-2006]

- A. On-street parking east of Route 1A on Amesbury Street and Newbury Street, and between Haverhill Street and Hooksett Street, is designated for property owners at Seabrook Beach, with the exception of the following locations in which uptown Seabrook residents may park:

- B. On-street parking on streets north of Hooksett Street shall be restricted to Seabrook residents by special permit only. This amendment shall be effective upon passage.

- C. "Uptown Seabrook resident" is defined as any resident of the Town of Seabrook having his/her primary residence west of the Blackwater River.
- D. The provisions of §§ 249-17 and 249-21 shall be in effect from 1:00 a.m. on the Friday of Memorial Day weekend to 12:00 midnight September 15.

§ 249-19. Parking permits. [Amended 6-21-1989, ratified 3-15-1990 ATM by Art. 17; 3-11-1993 ATM by Art. 13; 2-8-2005 ATM by Art. 50;² BOS 9-28-2005]

The issuance of on-street parking permits and placards for parking at Seabrook Beach in areas designated in § 249-18 of this chapter shall be as follows:

- A. Parking permits (self-adhesive) shall be issued by the Town Clerk to residents of the Town of Seabrook for each vehicle for which the Town Clerk issues a State of New Hampshire motor vehicle registration. Parking permits shall be valid for the time period specified in § 249-18C.
- B. Parking permits issued under § 249-19A(1) shall be displayed on the lower left corner of the motor vehicle's rear window or the driver side rear window.
- C. Two parking placards (heavy-duty paper) shall be issued annually only to the owners of property at Seabrook Beach who make application therefor and demonstrate residency in the Town of Seabrook. "Residency" for the purposes of this section is defined as any person who registers his motor vehicle within the Town of Seabrook and/or those persons on the official Seabrook checklist ("checklist" meaning the voter checklist). Said placards are for use only for the guests of Seabrook Beach property owners for display on cars or up to standard-size pickup trucks only.
- D. Parking placards shall be displayed in the front or rear left hand windows of the motor vehicle.

**ARTICLE IV
Schedules**

§ 249-20. Schedule I: Traffic Control Signals.

In accordance with the provisions of § 249-5, traffic control signals shall be installed at the following described intersections:

§ 249-21. Schedule II: Speed Limits. [Amended BOS 6-27-1990, ratified 3-12-1991 ATM by Art. 12; BOS 9-28-2005]

In accordance with the provisions of § 249-6, the speed limit for all streets in the Town of Seabrook on streets and highways under the legal control of the Town of Seabrook is 30 miles per hour except on such streets as may be listed under this schedule where a traffic study is completed in accordance with state requirements that justifies a speed limit of not less than 25 miles per hour. Nothing contained in this section shall prevent the Town of Seabrook from posting advisory speed limits of less than 25 miles per hour on yellow signs in dangerous locations and in publicly owned parking lots or driveways.

(2) In accordance with § 249-14A and B, no person shall park within 15 feet of a fire hydrant or within 20 feet of an intersection on those portions of the above-listed streets where parking is permitted and signage is installed or the pavement is marked.

- B. The Board of Selectmen will be authorized to change which side parking is allowed where it conflicts with mail delivery. **[Added 3-13-2001 ATM by Art. 40]**
- C. The Board of Selectmen are authorized to issue special parking permits to allow handicapped or disabled Seabrook residents to park in any restricted parking zone east of Route 1A that is otherwise restricted regardless of the handicapped or disabled resident's location of residence. **[Added 3-9-2004 ATM by Art. 43^a]**

§ 249-26. Schedule VII: Parking Prohibited at Certain Times.

In accordance with the provisions of § 249-11.1, no person shall park a vehicle at any of the times indicated upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets.
